<u>Rifle 1-Day Shooting Clinic</u> Aug 31-Rimfire Known Distance

Would you like to be able to make hits out to 500 yards with YOUR rifle?

Learn the "Six steps to firing the shot." Learn correct firing positions and proper sling use. Hear some little-known Revolutionary War history and reaffirm your heritage. Become a more influential citizen and make America a better place by using "The Seventh Step."

What you should bring:

A desire to learn and improve (a teachable attitude). Centerfire or .22 rimfire rifle, or both. Scope OK. Sling strongly recommended. 250 rounds of ammunition <u>per day, per rifle</u>. Eye and ear protection. Mat or ground cloth. Hat and sunscreen. Rain gear, layered clothes. Water – food on site. Some friends!

What you can expect:

New shooters - learn the fundamentals and make quick progress. Experienced shooters - learn techniques to tighten your groups. Expert shooters – polish your shooting AND teaching skills. Everyone – expect to have a great time!

Rimfire and centerfire to .32 caliber ok. NO TRACER or AMOR PIERCING AMMO

Pistolseed 2-Day Shooting Clinic Sept 28 & 29; Dec 28 & 29

Our pistol clinics cover the gamut of pistol marksmanship and defensive techniques. Your morning will begin with safety and safe handling of a firearm. From there you learn things such as the natural point of aim and what are those six steps to firing a shot. As your day progresses you will start learning how to shrink your groups and eventually how to fire rapidly and accurately. By the end of day one you will be placing 10 rounds from two separate mags into a target in under 15 seconds. Oh, if that is not tough enough for you we will also be doing drills on multiple targets with 10 rounds from two mags in 15 seconds. Do you know how to shoot both left and right-handed? If not, we will teach you.


