



RIMFIRE SPORTER MATCH SAT. NOV. 2

This is a non sanctioned competition. All CMP RIMFIRE SPORTER rules apply. The rifle must be a standard, sporter-type rifle chambered for the .22 Long Rifle cartridge only.

Special shooting jackets, trousers or shooting boots are prohibited. The rifle may be manually operated of semi-auto. Rifles should be repeater type with 2 magazines that hold a minimum of five rounds. A sling no more than 1 1/4 inches wide and an unpadded work ypr glove may be used. If you have any questions, contact Jerry Miller at 352-613-1061. There are 3 classes of competition: O-Class (open sights), T-Class (scope sighted or open aperture sighted), Tactical (AR 15 or Military style .22LR rifle). REGISTRATION BEGINS AT 11:45 AM AT THE 50 YD RANGE. FEES ARE \$8 ADULT AND \$5 JUNIORS (ages 10-18 years).

2024 200-Yard cmp High-Power Rifle Match November 23

Course of Fire: 10 sighters in at time limit of 10 minutes.

- Match 1: 100 yards prone, 10 shots for record in a time limit of 5 minutes.
- Match 2: 100 yards prone from standing, 10 shots with a magazine change in a time limit of 60 seconds. Hasty sling only.
- Match 3: 100 yards sitting or kneeling from standing, 10 shots with a magazine change in a time limit of 60 seconds. Hasty sling only.
- Match 4: 100 yards standing, 10 shots in time limit of 10 minutes. No sling may be used.

• Match 5: Aggregate of matches 1, 2, 3, & 4. Authorized Rifles:

Any M1 Carbine that complies with Rule 5.2.1;

Director's Match: M4 Carbines (including commercial equivalents) with barrels no longer than 16 inches (not including muzzle device).

Hernando Sportsman's Club is now an official affiliated Steel Challenge Club! Our club # is SCSA247. Our monthly matches consist of a minimum of 4 classifier stages. This allows a shooter to become classified by shooting just one of our regular monthly matches.

Steel Challenge consists of 8 nationally recognized stages. Each stage has a 5target array of steel plates that are engaged by each shooter for five consecutive timed runs. The best 4 out of 5 Times runs of each stage are totaled for the shooter's score. The lowest overall time in each class wins.

Competition schedule: Match day registration begins at 8::15 am. Safety Briefing at 9:00. Shooters must attend the Safety Briefing to be eligible to shoot. Entry fee is \$11 for club members and \$16 for nonmembers for one gun only. Pre-signup is highly recommended and can be done www.matchsignup.org.


Classes include Centerfire handguns, Rimfire handguns & Rifles and PPC (pistol caliber carbines).



Some folks need to see more than holes in paper to get a sense of accomplishment that comes with a well-placed shot. That's where the sport of silhouette shooting comes in. 



Match will be run under IDPA and Hernando Sportsman's Club rules.

The intent of the Defensive Pistol Match is to simulate self-defense scenarios and real-life encounters or skills. It is geared toward the new or average shooter, yet is fun, challenging and rewarding for the experienced shooter. The main goal is to test the skill and ability of the individual, not equipment or gamesmanship.

You will need about 100 rounds of ammunition, a belt holster, magazine pouches for 2 magazines/speed loaders and 3 magazines or speed loaders. NO SHOULDER HOLSTERS OR BEHIND THE BACK HOLSTERS ARE AL-LOWED DUE TO SAFETY CONCERNS. Almost any noncompensated handgun with a barrel shorter than 5.3 inches (revolvers 4-inch barrel) can be

shorter than 5.3 inches (revolvers 4-inch barrel) can be used.
